

In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles and in the Gospel passage from John, we read of astonishing events that called cowering disciples to step out of hiding and proclaim news that would condemn them and change the world forever! In the second reading Paul's words reach out into the future to us: "we were all given to drink of one Spirit" (1 Corinthians 12:13).

It is our task to truly pray today's psalm response. Let us together beg the Holy Spirit to renew the earth by renewing the Church, sending many more men and women to serve in its various ministries.

**LIFE, JUSTICE AND PEACE  
CATHOLIC TEACHING PUT INTO PRACTICE**

This is a series that will supply portions of the new encyclical from Pope Francis, entitled Fratelli Tutti.

**Neighbors without borders**

80. Jesus told the parable of the Good Samaritan in answer to the question: Who is my neighbor? The word "neighbor", in the society of Jesus' time, usually meant those nearest us. It was felt that help should be given primarily to those of one's own group and race. For some Jews of that time, Samaritans were looked down upon, considered impure. They were not among those to be helped. Jesus, himself a Jew, completely transforms this approach. He asks us not to decide who is close enough to be our neighbor, but rather that we ourselves become neighbors to all.

81. Jesus asks us to be present to those in need of help, regardless of whether or not they belong to our social group. In this case, the Samaritan became a neighbor to the wounded Judean. By approaching and making himself present, he crossed all cultural and historical barriers. Jesus concludes the parable by saying: "Go and do likewise" (Lk 10:37). In other words, he challenges us to put aside all differences and, in the face of suffering, to draw near to others with no questions asked. I should no longer say that I have neighbors to help, but that I must myself be a neighbor to others.

**LA VIDA, JUSTICIA Y PAZ  
LA ENSEÑANZA CATÓLICA PUESTA EN PRÁCTICA**

*Esta es una serie que proporcionará porciones de la nueva encíclica del Papa Francisco titulada Fratelli Tutti.*

**El prójimo sin fronteras**

*80. Jesús propuso esta parábola para responder a una pregunta: ¿Quién es mi prójimo? La palabra "prójimo" en la sociedad de la época de Jesús solía indicar al que es más cercano, próximo. Se entendía que la ayuda debía dirigirse en primer lugar al que pertenece al propio grupo, a la propia raza. Un samaritano, para algunos judíos de aquella época, era considerado un ser despreciable, impuro, y por lo tanto no se lo incluía dentro de los seres cercanos a quienes se debía ayudar. El judío Jesús transforma completamente este planteamiento: no nos invita a preguntarnos quiénes son los que están cerca de nosotros, sino a volvernos nosotros cercanos, prójimos.*

*81. La propuesta es la de hacerse presentes ante el que necesita ayuda, sin importar si es parte del propio círculo de pertenencia. En este caso, el samaritano fue quien se hizo prójimo del judío herido. Para volverse cercano y presente, atravesó todas las barreras culturales e históricas. La conclusión de Jesús es un pedido: «Tienes que ir y hacer lo mismo» (Lc 10,37). Es decir, nos interpela a dejar de lado toda diferencia y, ante el sufrimiento, volvemos cercanos a cualquiera. Entonces, ya no digo que tengo "prójimos" a quienes debo ayudar, sino que me siento llamado a volverme yo un prójimo de los otros.*

## TREASURES FROM TRADITION

The roots of today's "birthday of the Church" are in an ancient Jewish festival of springtime harvest, seven weeks after Passover. Now, seven weeks after Easter, our great fifty days of rejoicing come to an end. In the countries where the Church first came to life, this is a time of harvest, and the first fruits appear: apricots and lemons, cherries and strawberries. Even in our gardens, herbs are abundant and asparagus, that close relation of the Easter lily, comes fresh to our tables. The earth is laden with so much new life, and that has always been a sign to Christians of Easter's glory.

Pentecost means "fifty" and our fifty days of Easter joy are complete. This Sunday is a day to savor the glory of Easter once more: picnics and cookouts, walks by the water, time in the garden—are all ways of extending the feast. Notice the paschal candle today, still burning during Mass. Our Easter celebration now complete, the candle will soon be moved to a place near the baptismal font, and be lighted at baptisms and funerals as a silent witness to Christ's abiding presence.

Esta Iglesia también sería la que defendería al nativo y el mestizo de los abusos del Conquistador. Este sueño de Utopía, se quedó en sueño pero, es un sueño que continua en el pueblo latino y su devoción al Espíritu Santo de la Santísima Trinidad.

**THANK YOU** to the 655 families that have made a pledge to the Capital Campaign, moving us closer to Father Joe's vision of a debt-free home for our parish family.






